This course also counts toward the Jr. Master Scuba Diver rating, the highest rating in non-professional recreational scuba diving.

- Preparation: Read Rescue Diver Manual Chaps. 3 & 4
- Preparation: Complete Knowledge 3 & 4
- Classroom: Modules 3 & 4
- Classroom: Dive Rescue Scenario Project
- Shore: Rescue Diver Skills

## **DAY 4 (9am – 3pm)**

- Preparation: Read Rescue Diver Manual Chap. 5
- Preparation: Complete Knowledge 5
- Shore: Rescue Diver Skills
- Classroom: Final Exam
- Classroom: Project Sharing

## **DAY 5 (8am – 4pm)**

- Preparation: Gather items for boat day
- Boat: Rescue Diver Skills
- Log Dives, Certifications, Celebration

PADI is the Professional Association of Diving Instructors -- the world's largest scuba certification agency. Pre-register at Jack's Diving Locker in advance and pick up course materials.
