



# Open Water SCUBA Camp



This is the PADI Open Water Diver Program customized for Juniors. Includes knowledge development, shallow water skill dives and 4 open water dives from the boat and the shore. Upon successful completion of the program, students will receive the Jr. Open Water certification.

## **COST:**

- \$350.00 plus tax & materials

## **PREREQUISITES:**

- Ages 12 -18
- Ages 10 -11 (must be Master Seal Team members, have instructor approval and based on space availability)

- Answer Knowledge Reviews 3 & 4 (Before class)
- Academics 3 & 4
- Shallow Water SCUBA skills
- Watermanship assessment - 10 min tread & 200 yard swim

## **DAY 3 (9 am - 3 pm)**

- Read and watch Module 5 (Before class)
- Answer Knowledge Reviews 5 & prepare for test (Before class)
- Academics 5 & test
- Shallow Water SCUBA skills

## **DAY 4 SHORE DIVES! (9 am - 4 pm)**

- Prepare items for beach day - gear, logbook, tables, hat, sunscreen, lunch, snacks, water bottle (Before class)
- Open Water Dives 1 & 2

## **DAY 5 BOAT DIVES! (8 am - 4 pm)**

- Prepare items for boat day - gear, logbook, tables, hat, sunscreen, lunch, snacks, water bottle (Before class)
- Open Water Dives 3 & 4
- Certifications issued upon completion

All courses include instruction by PADI certified Instructors and Divemasters. All camps follow PADI course outlines. PADI is the Professional Association of Diving Instructors -- the world's largest scuba certification agency. Cancellations must be made 72 hours or more in advance or charge will be incurred. Minimum 3, Maximum 8 students.

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
