



# Specialty Camp Buoyancy & Boat Diver



Divers who master buoyancy control move through the water gracefully, soar over pristine coral reefs, and hover over delicate marine life. In this week-long day camp, students will learn the secrets to peak performance buoyancy – one of the most important skills in recreational scuba diving. Students will also learn boating basics and how to get the most from boat diving while on our Two-Tank Day Charter. In preparation for the week's diving, students will also review scuba skills to enhance safety and fun. Camp includes academics, skill dives, and five open water dives - three from the shore and two from the boat! Upon successful completion of the course work, students will receive the PADI Peak Performance Buoyancy Specialty and the PADI Boat Diver Specialty. These specialties count toward the PADI Master Scuba Diver rating, the highest rating in non-professional recreational scuba diving.
