This week long day camp is filled with fun and adventure for certified divers who want to learn more about diving. First, students will review and have a chance to improve basic scuba skills with refresher dives in the pool and off shore. Next, students will learn about amazing marine life and aquatic ecology with the PADI UW Naturalist Specialty course. In addition, students get to study and identify reef fish in the PADI AWARE Fish ID Specialty course. These specialties count toward the Jr. Master Scuba Diver rating, the highest rating in non-professional recreational scuba diving. In this camp, students will do both shore and boat dives with a total of 6 Open Water Dives!

COST:

- \$350.00 plus tax & materials

PREREQUISITES:

- Ages 10 -18
- Up to 4 spots only for ages 10 - 11
- Junior Open Water certification of higher
- Bring certification card

WE PROVIDE:

- Instruction, BCD, Regulator, Tanks, Weight, Wetsuit

- Swimsuit, towel, sunscreen
- Rash guard (surf shirt), dry clothes

REGISTRATION:

- Medical history form: Parents fill out for children. If any questions have been answered **YES**, student must have a doctor's approval **before** starting camp. Parents please get the medical release for the doctor from the shop first.
