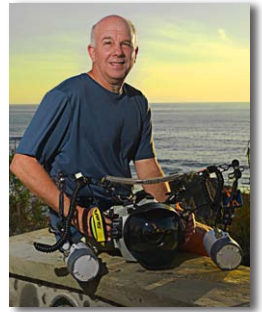




Jack's Diving Locker Presents: Underwater Photography with Marty Snyderman
