



Assistant Instructor Course



The PADI Assistant Instructor (AI) course is offered to Divemasters ready to gain more knowledge and experience in the PADI system of education. This program gives candidates the opportunity to divide their journey of instructor training into smaller increments that may help with scheduling and financing concerns. The Assistant Instructor course is scheduled during the Instructor Development Course (IDC) or as a stand-alone program scheduled throughout the year. Certified AI's act as instructional assistants and assume some teaching responsibilities. This includes presenting knowledge development elaboration for any PADI Diver course under the indirect supervision of an instructor, presenting initial skills training in confined water under direct supervision of an instructor, and independently conducting PADI Seal Team Aqua Missions as well as PADI Specialty courses such as Coral Reef Conservation or Project AWARE. The experience of assisting and teaching helps AI's build confidence prior to the Open Water Scuba Instructor (OWSI) course and Instructor Examination (IE), the next step in professional scuba diving career development.

- 18 years old
- 60 logged dives: documented experience in night diving, deep diving and underwater navigation.
- Certified diver for six months
- Medical clearance attesting to dive fitness signed by a physician within the previous 12 months.
- Emergency First Response Primary and Secondary Care course completion (or qualifying training) within the last 24 months.
- Open Water, Advanced, Rescue, and Divemaster certifications (or equivalent).
- DAN Insurance
