



Underwater Navigation Specialty Course



Rise to the challenge and head your diving in the right direction! Exploring the underwater world is much more enjoyable and safe with navigation skills. You can learn these skills in the PADI Underwater Navigation Specialty course with academic sessions and three open water dives from the boat or shore. The benefits of underwater navigation include making your dive plan more effective as well as putting you in control of your dive. These skills may also help you save energy, reduce air consumption, and be a better buddy. PADI Advanced Open Water divers can use the Underwater Navigation Dive in their advanced course as Dive One and simply upgrade by successfully completing the academic session and Day Two of this schedule.

COST:

- \$330 plus tax (Private class: \$500)
- Upgrade from Advanced Open Water (DAY 2):
 - \$190 plus tax (min. of 2)
 - \$250 plus tax (one student or private)

PREREQUISITES:

- Open Water Diver Certification
- Recommended minimum age - 12 years old (minimum age - 10 yrs old)

TIME REQUIRED:

- 2 days - 3 dives
- Scheduled by request
